Our scholarship program for graduating high school seniors is at three (currently \$1,500 per scholarship). A task force, spearheaded by your board of directors has decided that we will double our scholarship program in numbers of scholarships (from 3 to 6) and we will raise the award from 1,500 to \$2,000. In addition we are investigating other possibilities with scholarships for wounded warriors and supporting the national aid program title "Wounded Warriors".

We have met as a board with Bill Jones (He just contributed \$1,000), Valerie Hepburn (President, College of Coastal Georgia), and Woody Woodside of the Chamber of commerce to discuss the methodology of how to collect corporate donations. From these contracts we have decided that we will form two procurement teams to contact any and all companies and organizations to help raise the funds to support our goals.

Vernon Martin set a standard for this organization by personally raising \$3,400 (34 raffle books) plus \$1,000 in donations. If one man can do this just think what could happen if all members agreed to be a part of the working team?
